The goal is to develop realistic, relevant-to-the-times stories that will train soldiers on the more nuanced issues associated with cultural interactions especially in military operations.

Subject candidate should have specific knowledge of tribal/country area cultural Values, Beliefs, Behaviors, and Norms (VBBNs). The job requires strong proficiency in writing skills to help us work on educational products that help prepare deploying soldiers for interacting foreign cultures and tribal negotiations. Must have had extensive interaction with local populace in Afghanistan. Must have proficiency in squad level tactics. Foreign language training (Arabic, Pashtun, etc) desired by not required.
